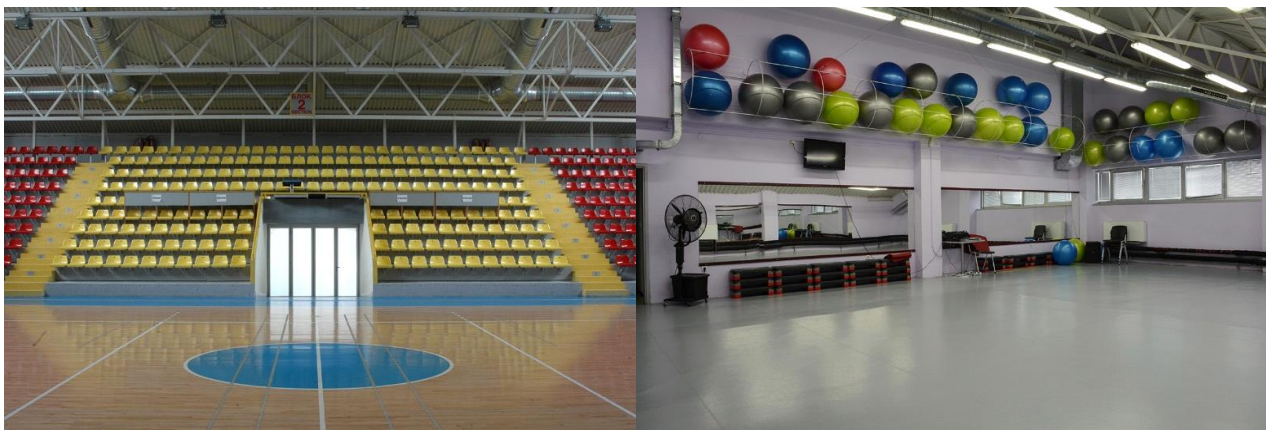

bul. 8 Septeber, No 13, 1000 Skopje**

Partly open ice rink, 56m x 28m, located 2800m from the center of Skopje. The Ice rink is roof covered. The Ice rink is part of the Sports Center "Boris Trajkovski" which offers closed and good climatized sport halls and wardrobes, as shown on the following photos.



Note:

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel "Skopje on ICE 2022" if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision or recommendation of the national or local government will not permit to conduct an event or if travel restrictions of

the Republic of North Macedonia will block the teams for entry or departure, without compensation. Skaters are advised to seek advice from their relevant government agencies, travel and medical providers regarding travel to any country and any affective restrictions in place. The restrictions can change at a short notice. Program may be changed according to number of entered skaters. - Entries:** **OPEN NATIONAL FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION**
INTERCLUB FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION
Each club may enter 3 competitors in each category: Senior (three ladies), Junior (three ladies), Advanced novice (three boys and three girls), Basic novice (three boys and three girls), Cubs (three boys and three girls), Chicks (three boys and three girls) Interpretative A, B and C (3 girls in each level) . The Organizer reserves the right to enter more competitors in each category.
- Entries should contain: name and surname of the competitor, date of birth and category. Only complete entries will be accepted.
- Deadline for entries:** The entries should arrive to the Skating Federation of North Macedonia via e-mail: skatingfederationmk@gmail.com, not later than **February 10, 2022**.

- Charges:** »**SKOPJE ON ICE 2022**« a fee of **30 EUR** is to be paid for each competitor for all categories.
- Entry fee to be paid on account of: NLB TUTUNSKA BANKA AD Skopje, IBAN MK07210722000062050, SWIFT: TUTNMK22 or before the competition on the spot in the office of the organizer during the accreditation.
- Responsibilities:** All participants act on their own responsibility. The organizer will provide medical aid during competition and practice.
- Music:** Music will be reproduced from a CD player (normal speed) **Audio CD-s (not mp3)** must be labeled clearly with the competitor's name, Club/National Federation and category in which the competitor is competing. Such labeled CD-s should be delivered to the organizer immediately after the arrival.
- Judging System:** The ISU Judging System will be used.
- Expenses:** The full board hotel accommodation for the invited Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers and Specialists will

be arranged and covered by the organizer starting with dinner on Friday, February 18, finishing with lunch on Saturday, February 19, 2022. Travel costs for invited Referees and Judges will be covered by the organizer. The Organizer will not be able to cover any expense for competitors, team leaders and coaches.

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2021 and respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR Man:

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2021 and respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR Ladies:

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2021 and respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE Boys:

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2396 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min 00 sec, +/-10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE Girls:

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2396 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min 00 sec, +/-10 sec

- » **INTERCLUB FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION «**

BASIC NOVICE BOYS and GIRLS: born from 01.07.2008 – 30.06.2011

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2396 and all respective ISU Communications.

CUBS Boys and Girls: born from 1.7.2011 – 30.6.2013.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- There must be a maximum:
 - for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
 - for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For Cubs in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in:

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factor of the Program Components is 2.5. The deduction for the fall is only -0.5.

CHICKS Boys and Girls: born from 1.7.2013 – and younger

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program must contain:

- Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double Jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- There must be a maximum:
 - for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
 - for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The Factor of the Program Components is 2.5. The deduction for the fall is only -0.5.

Levels explanations: For CHICKS Singles, in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

INTERPRETATIVE

Levels:

C.) Aged less than 10 until 01.07 before the competition.

Free program duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min. (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced Free Skating program may contain maximum 3 jumps. No jump can be repeated, jump combinations are not allowed.

B.) Aged between 10 and 15 until 01.07 before the competition.

Free program duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min. (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced Free Skating program may contain maximum 4 jumps. No jump can be repeated, jump combinations are not allowed.

A.) Aged 15 until 01.07 before the competition

Free program duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min 30 sec (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced Free Skating program may contain maximum 5 jump elements, one of which may be a jump combination. Any jump can be repeated only once, in a jump combination.

Music: No limit, vocal music is accepted.

Costumes: according to the interpretation of the music-theme.

Objects – accessories are allowed if not dangerous for the ice.

Calculation of results for categories Interpretative A, B i C is ISU Judging System – Program Components only.

Attention: if a program with other jumps, those will be calculated as illegal.
