<u>GENERAL:</u> The SKATE HELENA MINI 2023 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating, pertinent ISU Communications, as well as European Criterium Regulations for Chicks and Cubs.

Participation in the SKATE HELENA MINI 2023 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in this Announcement and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it.

EUROPEAN CRITERIUM TROPHY: SKATE HELENA MINI 2023 is associated with the European Criterium Tournament 2022/23 for Junior, Novice and younger categories. Results of the Teams will count for competition of International Trophy of Figure Skating European Criterium. Individual points are automatically calculated for all skaters in every category and those are valid in the European Criterium Tournament in the same category. The age requirements and the special regulation for the European Criterium Trophy are published on the website of the EC: www.europeancriterium.eu



TECHNICAL DATA:

Place of the competition:

Ledena dvorana - Ice hall, Čarlija Čaplina 39, Belgrade, Serbia The rink is indoor, but not heated. The size of the rink is 60 m x 30 m.

CATEGORIES:

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Intermediate Novice skater is who was born: 1.7.2007 and younger. Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2489 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +\- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Basic Novice skater is who was born: 1.7.2009 and younger. However, Basic Novice Girls are divided in three subgroups:

Born on 1.7.2009 and younger Born on 1.7.2010 and younger Born on 1.7.2011 and younger BASIC NOVICE GIRLS II. BASIC NOVICE GIRLS III.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2489 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +\- 10 sec

CUBS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is, who was born: 1.7.2012 – 30.6.2013

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is, who was born: 1.7.2013 – 30.6.2014

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS BOYS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is, who was born: 1.7.2012 - 30.6.2014

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is, who was born: 1.7.2014 – 30.6.2015

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is, who was born: 1.7.2015 and younger.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS BOYS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is, who was born: 1.7.2014 and younger

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec



A well balanced CUBS and CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump in to the take- off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value.

No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed. Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.

- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position. The spin combination with a change of foot and a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. The spin in one position with a change of foot minimum of eight (8) revolutions or spin in one position without change of foot minimum of six (6) revolutions. In both spins flying entries are allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Level explanation: For all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is 1.67

All other General rules and Technical Requirements are the same as ISU rule for Single Skating Basic Novice - Girls and Boys written in Communication No. 2489.

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

ENTRIES

Competitors must be entered through their clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU. Each club may enter 2 competitors in each category (2 males and 2 females). The organizing club reserves the right to enter more competitors.

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

The entries for the competition must be done via web portal – www.europeancriterium.eu.

Before entry procedure a representative of each federation/club needs to apply for a new account on www.europeancriterium.eu/Account/Register. Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to the proper protection of personal data in accordance with the European Union GDPR Regulation. Therefore, in the context of Privacy Policy, the appropriate consent is required in the applications.

Closing date for the entries is December 23rd, 2022.

ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Member may nominate Judges for the event. ISU Championships, International Judges and National will be accepted. However, the OC reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with the number of the Skaters' Entries. The Organizing Committee will only cover the board and lodging for judges accepted in the panel in the hotel HERITAGE from dinner on Wednesday, January 18th, 2023 until lunch on Friday, January 19th, 2023 or in the days when the Judge is on duty. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Member by e-mail by January 5th, 2023.

ENTRY FEE:

65 EUR per skater in Categories Chicks and Cubs.

70 EUR per skater in Categories Basic Novices and Intermediate Novices.

Entry fee must be paid to the bank account of the Organizer until December 23rd, 2023.

In case of late entry or late payment organizer has the right to reject the entry or to charge bigger entry fee, 80 EUR/competitor.

MUSIC - NEW

It is mandatory to upload files with music the competitors need for their performances. The entry process is the following:

- Competitors are entered; after the confirmation of the entry, there is an option to attach the appropriate music file to competitor's application.
- The competitor's application is "pending" until the music files are uploaded.
- When the music files are attached to application the status of competitor's entry changes to active status and the competitor is included in the official competitors list of selected competition.

Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format.

Files must be labelled with the name of the name of the category, segment, name(s) of the competitor and ISU Member abbreviation.

Examples:

BasicNoviceGirls1 FS ROGIC-Leona SRB

CubsBoys FS MARJANOVIC-Marko SRB

Organizers of competitions can download a music file of selected competitor and download a full package of files ordered and grouped by the categories.

By uploading the music, the applicant agrees that in the case of an incorrect or low-quality recording of the music, the Organizer shall reproduce the music of its choice (with the playing time corresponding to the required time for each Segment for each Category) during the Event.



COMPETITORS MUST HAVE COPY OF THEIR MUSIC .MP3 FILES ON USB KEY (OR ANY EXTERNAL USB DRIVE) AT THE COMPETITION.

CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS: All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System.

DRAW: Draw for all categories will be performed in the presence of the Referee and Technical Controller in accordance with Rules 512 and 513 at 19:00 hour, Wednesday January 18th, 2023. The link for the online presence will be also provided.

EXPENSES: Organizer covers the accommodation expenses with full board only for the confirmed Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists in the Hotel HERITAGE Belgrade. Expenses for accommodation and meals for Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the Organizer.

AWARDS: The Organizer provides diplomas for all competitors after each event. The three best Skaters in each category will be awarded by medals.

LIABILITY: In accordance with ISU Regulations, Rule 119, all participants act on their own responsibility. Organizer will provide medical emergency aid during competition.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE: The Office of the Organizing Committee will be located on the ice-rink and will be on disposal from Wednesday January, 18th 2023, and during the whole event.
