COMPETITORS MUST HAVE COPY OF THEIR MUSIC .MP3 FILES ON USB KEY (OR ANY EXTERNAL USB DRIVE) AT THE COMPETITION.
Draw: Draw for all categories will be performed in the presence of the Referee and Technical Controller in accordance with Rules 512 and 513 at 19:00 hour, Thursday, February 29th, 2024. The link for the online presence will be also provided.

Judging System: All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System.
Expenses: The full board hotel accommodation for the invited Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers and Specialists will be arranged and covered by the organizer starting with dinner on Friday, March 01, finishing with lunch on Saturday, March 02, 2024. Travel costs for invited Referees and Judges will be covered by the organizer. The Organizer will not be able to cover any expense for competitors, team leaders and coaches.

## SENIOR Women \& Men:

Free Skating: $\mathbf{4} \mathbf{~ m i n ~} \mathbf{0 0} \mathbf{~ s e c},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$

## JUNIOR Women \& Men:

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2022 and respective ISU Communications.
Short Program: $2 \min 40 \mathrm{sec},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$
Free Skating: $\mathbf{3} \mathbf{~ m i n ~} 30 \mathbf{~ s e c},+/-10 \mathbf{~ s e c}$

## ADVANCED NOVICE Girls \& Boys:

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2562 and all respective ISU Communications.
Short Program: $2 \min 20 \mathrm{sec},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$
Free Skating: $3 \mathrm{~min} 00 \mathrm{sec},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$

## 2. MINI CATEGORIES:

## BASIC NOVICE BOYS ang GIRLS: born from 01.07.2008 and younger

Free Skating: 2 min $30 \mathrm{sec},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$
Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2562 and all respective ISU Communications.

CUBS Boys and Girls: born from 1.7.2013-30.6.2015.
Free Skating: $2 \mathrm{~min},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$

CHICKS Boys and Girls: born from 1.7.2015 and younger
Free Skating: $2 \mathrm{~min},+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$
A well balanced CUBS and CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain: a) Maximum of 4 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations
or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump in to the take- off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value. No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed. Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once. b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position. The spin combination with a change of foot and a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. The spin in one position with a change of foot minimum of eight (8) revolutions or spin in one position without change of foot minimum of six (6) revolutions. In both spins flying entries are allowed. c) There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface. Level explanation: For all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.
The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is 1.67
All other General rules and Technical Requirements are the same as ISU rule for Single Skating Basic Novice - Girls and Boys written in Communication No. 2562. The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

## 3. INTERPRETATIVE CATEGIRIES

## Levels:

C.) Aged less than 10 until 01.07 before the competition.

Free program duration:
Boys and Girls: $2 \mathrm{~min} .(+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$.)
A well balanced Free Skating program may contain maximum 3 jumps. No jump can be repeated, jump combinations are not allowed.

## B.) Aged between 10 and 15 until 01.07 before the competition.

Free program duration:
Boys and Girls: $2 \mathrm{~min} .(+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$.
A well balanced Free Skating program may contain maximum 4 jumps. No jump can be repeated, jump combinations are not allowed.

## A.) Aged 15 and older

Free program duration:
Boys and Girls: $2 \mathrm{~min} 30 \mathrm{sec}(+/-10 \mathrm{sec}$.
A well balanced Free Skating program may contain maximum 5 jump elements, one of which may be a jump combination. Any jump can be repeated only once, in a jump combination.

Music: No limit, vocal music is accepted.
Costumes: according to the interpretation of the music-theme.
Objects - accessories are allowed if not dangerous for the ice.
Calculation of results for categories Interpretative A, B i C is ISU Judging System - Program Components only.

Attention: if a program with other jumps, those will be calculated as illegal.
