ANNOUNCEMENT

The FIGURES Synchronised Skating Club has the great pleasure to invite ISU Members to participate in the 2nd Spring Synchro Cup, an Interclub Synchronized Skating Competition.

GENERAL

The Spring Synchro Cup 2024 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Spring Synchro Cup 2024 is open to all Teams who belong to an ISU member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 4 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

TECHNICAL DATA

All competition events and official practice sessions will be held at Belgrade Indoor Ice Rink (Ledena dvorana) in Belgrade, Čarli Čaplina 39.

The ice surface is 30 x 60 m, not heated.

ENTRIES

Entries of Team members and Entries of Teams should be made by FORM 01 not later than: Friday, April 5th, 2024, to the email address: prolecnisinhrokup@gmail.com.

RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Synchronized Skating 2022, Rule 842 and Rule 843 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

CATEGORIES

Elements of the programs must be in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, and the relevant ISU Communications (2553, 2563, 2554, 2566 and 2552).

MINI, U10

Skaters born on 1.7.2023 and younger have the right to participate in MINI category. Team is composed of 6-16 skaters, with maximum number of 4 alternate skaters.

FREE SKATING: (SKATING IN ONE THIRD OF THE ICE SURFACE)

Music duration: 2:00 (+/- 10 sec.); warm-up duration: 2:00;

Well balanced Free Skating Program must contain 5 (five) elements:

1. Block (B)
2. Wheel (W)
3. Line (L)
4. Circle (C)
5. One of the following elements:
 - Intersection (I), or
 - Move Element (ME)

Illegal elements: according to the Art. 992, para. 2. c).

The Program Components Factor is 2.67; fall deduction: 0,5 points.

Levels explanations:

In all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

JUVENILE, U13

Skaters born on 1.7.2020 and younger have the right to participate in JUVENILE category. Team is composed of 8-16 skaters, with maximum number of 4 alternate skaters.

FREE SKATING:

Music duration: 3:00 (+/- 10 sec.); warm-up duration: 2:00;

Well balanced Free Skating Program must contain 6 (six) elements:

BASIC NOVICE

Skaters born on in the period 1.7.2008 - 30.6.2013 have the right to participate in BASIC NOVICE category. Team is composed of 12-16 skaters, with maximum number of 4 alternate skaters.

FREE SKATING:

Music duration: 3:00 (+/- 10 sec.); warm-up duration: 2:00;

Well balanced Free Skating Program must contain 6 (six) elements:

ADVANCE NOVICE

Skaters born on in the period 1.7.2008-30.6.2013 have the right to participate in ADVANCE NOVICE category. Team is composed of 12-16 skaters, with maximum number of 4 alternate skaters.

FREE SKATING:

Music duration: 3:00 (+/- 10 sec.); warm-up duration: 2:00;

Well balanced Free Skating Program must contain 6 (six) elements:

1. Intersection Element (I)
2. Move Element (ME)
3. No Hold Element (NHE).
4. Synchronized spin (SySp)
5. Traveling element (TrE)
6. One of the following artistic elements:
 - Artistic Circle (AC), or
 - Artistic Line (AL)

Illegal elements: according to the Art. 992, para. 2. c).

The Program Components Factor is 2.67; fall deduction: 0,5 points.

Levels explanations:

In all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 4 will be counted.

MIX AGE

Team is composed of 8-16 skaters, with maximum number of 4 alternate skaters. No age limit.

FREE SKATING:

Music duration: 3:00 (+/- 10 sec.); warm-up duration: 2:00;

Well balanced Free Skating Program must contain the following elements:

- 1 Intersection Element
- Additional Feature – Point of Intersection (pi) is optional
 - 2 Move Element
- A maximum of four different types of fms are permitted - Only two different types of fms are permitted at the same time
 - 3 No Hold Element
- Feature and Additional Feature – Step Sequence will be called
- A maximum of step sequence level two (s2) will be called
 - 4 Pivoting Element – Block
 - 5 Synchronized Spin Element
 - 6 Twizzle Element
- PLUS a Choice of one of the following Artistic Elements listed in number 7
- 7 Artistic Element – Circle, or
Artistic Element – Wheel

Illegal elements: according to the Art. 992, para. 2. c).

The Program Components Factor is 2.67; fall deduction: 0,5 points.

Levels explanations:

In all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 3 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

The table shows the number of the skaters of the team which must fulfil the age requirement corresponding to the category.

Category	Skaters fulfilling the age requirements	Skaters NOT fulfilling the age requirements
Advanced Novice	100%	0%
Basic Novice	80%	20%
Juvenile, (<13)	80%	20%
Mini, (<10)	50%	50%

Remark: If skaters participate in more than one (1) Team, the number of same skaters in two different Teams cannot be higher than 50% of total number of skaters.
